

CDMP REGULATIONS FLOWCHART

Approved June 19, 2018 MCED #27/2018-2019

PHASE I - Drafting & Development

Step 1 → The Proponent completes the Regulation Application Form and sends to KLCC.

Step 2 → The Technical Drafting Committee (TDC comprised of lawyer, Portfolio Chief, Technician & Proponent) identifies (sends out public notification) & consults with stakeholders and community* for input when drafting or amending Regulations.

Step 3 → TDC drafts Regulations to reflect the spirit and intent of the law.

Step 4 → Council receives and considers Draft Regulations and approves any additional operational and/or financial costs.

Step 5 → Draft Regulations posted online (www.kahnawakemakingdecisions.com) for 30 days. First Community Input Process may occur during 30-day review period.

PHASE II - Input Process

Step 1 → Community Input Process. The TDC gathers input from the community starting from the date of publication of the draft regulation ending 30 days later.

Method of consultation can vary (i.e. kiosks, written memos, community consultation, etc.).

Revised Regulations & Legal Review presented to Chief and Council by the TDC.

PHASE III - Enactment

Step 1 → C & C gives final approval of Regulations through a MCED at a Legislative Session (duly convened Council Meeting).

Step 2 → Final Regulations are published online (www.kahnawakemakingdecisions.com).

*Extent of consultation determined by TDC when creation of a regulation or amendment to an existing regulation is minimal and consists of an increase in fines, prices, fees, tariffs, deductions or royalties.
