Title

KAHNAWÁ:KE INDIAN VILLAGE LAW

K.R.L. c. I-1

[Enacted by Kahnawá:ke By-Law # No. 6 13/68-69 Effective July 20th, 1968]

Preamble

WHEREAS the following conditions apply as to the operation of the Indian Village and the concession stands included within the Village Stockade located on Band Lot #77 and,

SECTION I

"Definition"

1. <u>DEFINITIONS</u>

"Sales or Exchange of Buildings" Sale or Exchange of Buildings: The sale of a building by one party to another shall not permit the buyer to use the space which the building occupies unless that buyer has the permission of the Council.

"Cleanliness"

Cleanliness: Each stand operator shall see that his or her stand shall be kept clean.

All stand operators shall co-operate to keep the whole area in a clean and sanitary condition.

"Dress"

Dress: All stand operators shall be required to dress in Indian Costumes.

SECTION II

"Conditions for Operating Stand"

2. <u>CONDITIONS FOR OPERATING STAND</u>

- 2.1 That the following conditions apply as to the operation of the Indian Village and the concession stands included within the Village Stockade located on Band Lot #77.
- 2.2 <u>People With Stands:</u> Only people who are unable to perform heavy work, elderly, destitute and in similar situations, shall be able to operate stands at the Indian Village.

- 2.3 <u>Requests:</u> Only people who have requested permission to operate a stand shall be permitted to do so provided the permission is renewed in the month of April of every year.
- 2.4 <u>Size of Land:</u> The maximum frontage allowed for each operator, shall be 24 feet provided that a stand and a tee-pee or wig-wam is placed within the area specified.

Stand operators with frontage of 15 feet or less require only a stand.

The size of the area and its availability will decide on it being allotted to a person.

No person shall use more than one stand or stand and tee-pee or wig-wam.

"Sales"

3. SALES

3.1 The selling of one concession by one operator to another person is prohibited.

"Operator Obligations"

4. OPERATOR OBLIGATIONS

- 4.1 Every stand operator shall behave in a manner worthy of the North American Indian people.
- Every person is prohibited from operating a stand at the Indian Village unless that person abides by the foregoing regulations as per S. 80 of the <u>Indian Act</u> R.S.C. 1952 c.149, sub-section (g) and (h).
