KAHNAWA:KE TOWN DUMP LAW

K.R.L. c. T-3

[Enacted by SOR/77-500 on Enacted 11 *Onerahtohkó:wa*/May, 1977]
[Repealed & Replaced on 8 *Ohiarihkó:wa*/July, 1987]

Preamble

WHEREAS this is a law to amend By-law D-1, passed and approved, at a duly convened meeting held at the Kahnawake Mohawk Council office, July 8, 1987, and enacted under the authority of Section 81 a), c) & r) and Section 82(2) of the Indian Act; and,

SECTION I

"Definitions"

1. DEFINITIONS

1.1 For the purpose of the present by-law:

"Caretaker"

The word "Caretaker" signifies the person named by the Mohawk Council for the dumping site.

"Dumping Site"

The word "Dumping Site" signifies the location chosen by the Mohawk Council for the depositing of refuse.

"Territory"

The word "Territory" signifies Kahnawake Mohawk Territory.

"Council"

The word "Council" signifies the Mohawk Council of the Kahnawake Mohawk Territory.

"Inspectors"

The word "Inspectors" signifies Mohawk Chiefs, the Peacekeeper Chief, all Peacekeepers or persons named by the Mohawk Council of Kahnawake.

"Hours to Open"

2. HOURS TO OPEN

2.1 Gates will be open these hours only:

7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. - Monday to Sunday

"Access for Residents"

3. ACCESS FOR RESIDENTS

3.1 Town dump is for Kahnawake residents only. No commercial dumping of off reserve refuse or materials.

"Transport of Refuse" 4. **TRANSPORT OF REFUSE**
4.1 Persons collecting and transporting refuse to dump site are themselves responsible that they do not drop any while loading or transporting.

"Dumping Site" 5. **DUMPING SITE**
5.1 All garbage and all other debris must be discarded at the territory dump located on Highway 138 across from the Old Bedard Quarry only.

"Caretaker" 6. **CARETAKER**
6.1 The Caretaker will give, at all times, directions where to dump on dumping site.

"Restrictions" 7. **RESTRICTIONS**
7.1 Positively no disposal of refuse or materials outside of fence.
7.2 Logs will be no longer than eighteen inches (18").
7.3 Unauthorized persons are absolutely forbidden from burning refuse or starting fires at the dump site.

SECTION II

"Penalties" 8. **PENALTIES**
8.1 For offences to all Articles, except 3.1, the offender found guilty will be subject to a fine of \$25.00 for first offence plus costs and \$50.00 plus costs for each subsequent offence.
8.2 For offences to Article 3.1, the offender found guilty will be subject to a fine of \$100.00 plus costs for the first offence and an additional \$100.00 plus costs for every subsequent offence to a maximum of \$1,000.00.
8.3 Non-payment of fines, the offender will be subjected to prison terms of not more than fourteen (14) days.

"By-Law No. 5" 9. **BY-LAW NO. 5**
9.1 This amendment to By-law D-1, does not infringe or abrogate By-law No. 5.
