CDMP PROPOSED REVISIONS: UPDATE/DECISION</b></p> <p>A) Regulations Policy &amp; Flowchart</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Revisited Regulations Policy discussion on Community Member Observer on the TDC - confirmed agreement on having member <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There will need to be criteria/guidelines developed for the non-active community participant</li> </ul> </li> <li>- Discussion clarifying KLCC (Unit/Services) role regarding administrative requirements for approval of regulations and collaboration with the Technical Drafting Committee (TDC).</li> </ul> <p>B) Background info for recent KLCC members:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- History of how laws &amp; regulations were drafted prior to the CDMP and where it is now regarding powers to enact. Open a discussion about the Regulations Policy applying to boards &amp; commissions that have been delegated the authority to enact regulations via their respective laws that created them. All regulations are enacted by an MCED. If those bodies are not required to come for an MCED it needs to be made clear since it is currently not consistent.</li> <li>- <b><u>ACTION→</u></b>: Tonya to bring to Council of Chiefs for discussion before deciding/concluding this section. Need to be clear if this policy applies across all boards and commissions or not, since at present it is not clear. Then the Policy can be brought back to the KLCC.</li> </ul>
