Previous ROC & KLCC Administration	<p>Please review the 01/13/15 ROC and send any changes by Friday @ 4:00 p.m. as they will be finalized at that time.</p> <p>A question was raised about when the new temporary administrative assistant would start and noted that HR was in process of finding a replacement.</p>
2. File Updates	<p>Tobacco - February 10, 2015 Community Consultation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The Tobacco Community Consultation Agenda was reviewed and approved by Peggy & KLCC. -Peggy advised that the following KTA representatives on the panel would be Devery Bauersfeld, Chucky McComber, Brian Delormier, Evan Standup, Kaienta'a Cross & Randy Cross. Gina Deer and Bobby Patton will represent the MCK. -It was agreed that the KTA would give a historical background of the law explaining why it was created. -Gina as the MCK representative would explain the importance of the law and explain the details of the MOU between the KTA and the MCK. <p>Two questions to be asked at the Consultation are:</p> <p>1) Does the community give the mandate to move the law through the CDMP?</p> <p>2) Does the community acknowledge that the Kahnawà:ke Tobacco Law is an urgent matter and needs to be expedited?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The Purpose, Scope & Intent and the feedback will be discussed at the First Hearing. -The selection of three community representatives will also be made at the First Hearing. -KLCC needs to direct people not on the KKR to the Observer's Table. The press release will also inform the community about participation at CDMP meetings and

	<p>being on the KKR. -Kahsennenhawe will do the opening and closing address -Leslie to do the Introduction (welcome, meeting guidelines, purpose of the consultation & CDMP consensus explanation). -Ron & Joe will facilitate when required and explain the Next Steps.</p> <p>ACTION: 1) Leslie to e-mail the agenda to Peggy and copy of ROC.</p> <p>KFHL – It was suggested that Leslie and another KLCC member visit Akwesasne to obtain more information on the door-to-door polling they are doing for their MRI Law.</p>
