File Updates	<p><u>Prioritization</u> Council Agenda Package for C & Cs approval of KLCC Prioritization of Laws for 2012 – 2015 Term of Office.</p> <p><u>Urgent Law Making</u> Received feedback in the form of a question on Urgent Law Making from two people. Council Agenda package to be prepared for RFD & MCED.</p> <p><u>Type II Process</u> Send to Communications for review out to the community until March 1 after which Council Agenda Package for RFD on Type II Process.</p> <p><u>Justice System (Act)</u> Drafting team reviewing. Should be ready to go back for 2nd Hearing and community approval in March 2013. Estimate up to 6 Justice meetings to receive approval on 2nd draft and Final 3rd Hearing for enactment.</p> <p><u>Membership Law</u> First Community Consultation asking community for the mandate to amend the KML is Jan. 24, 2013 with a second consultation scheduled Jan. 29, 2013. Both at Karonhianonha School from 6:00 p.m. – 8:30 p.m. Kahsennenhawe to address with C & C participation at Membership Hearings.</p> <p><u>Elections Law</u> Technical Team sent recommendations to Legal Services. Legal Services completed first draft. Should be ready to go the community in early spring.</p> <p><u>MRI</u> Paul Nicholas will be submitting Briefing Note to Council next week. Bill S-2 currently at 2nd Reading in House of Commons and has been referred to Status of Women’s Committee. After the Standing Committee, it’s expected to go for a 3rd and final reading then receive Royal Assent and come into force 12 months later. Also noted was that Kahnawà:ke would be using Six Nations draft law as basis for</p>

	Kahnawà:ke MRI Law.
3. OCC Connection to KLCC	No clear direction from OCC. KLCC needs to develop a long-term plan with the ultimate goal of autonomy.
4. CDMP Video	Draft copy that was submitted requires further revisions.
5. CDMP Telephone Survey	Lulu was introduced as the 26 week contracted employee through Tewatohnhi'saktha's Job Creation Program. She should be ready to begin conducting the CDMP telephone survey by the first week in February 2013. In order to ensure the elderly are reached, Lulu will interview them at the Elder's Lodge. Kahente will send a letter to Mike Horne, Manager Elders Lodge, and requesting approval.
6. Outreach – Kiosks & CDMP Presentations	Tewatohnhi'saktha Presentation was challenging. The next presentation is Feb. 5/13 from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at KMHC.
