# Other comments:

- It might be beneficial for the Sanitary Conditions Law (SCL) to include an accompanying document used as an explanation in plain English in addition to the legalese.
- There was potential for more participation and discussion, however people present may have felt intimidated by the more vocal participants.
- Suggestion for instruction manual for the Unit/Organization/Person(s) submitting an amendment request.

# Recommendations:

- Establish ground rules/rules of engagement prior to each reading
- Change venue selection it was based on in-house equipment in Large C.
- For security reasons, hold readings at PK Station
- Have a chairperson, facilitator & additional recorder
- Reiterate purpose of reading and not debating or reviewing CDMP
