1. 2011/12 LEGISLATIVE AGENDA

An update of the following Laws going through the CDMP was given:

Judicial Act

- Received a preliminary Draft of the Justice Act for information purposes.
- An update will be given as the Draft evolves.

Membership Law

- Survey completed

- Streamline CDMP Minimum Communication Standards to ensure standards are followed and it goes through the process first before any information is sent out to the public.

Sanitary Conditions Law (SCL)

The First Reading is May 9, 2011 @ 1:30 – 4:00 p.m. in the MCK Large Conference Room. The Draft Agenda was reviewed and accepted as follows:

Note: Linda informed she would be reading the SCL aloud and would emphasize that the Chiefs are participating as community members and not as Chiefs in Council. When the SCL gets to the legislative sessions, that's when the Chiefs function would be as Chiefs in Council and NOT community members.
- **Explanation of Amendments** by Heather Jacobs-Whyte
Note: Heather informed that the SCL was not meant for residents of Kahnawà:ke but for businesses and industries in Kahnawà:ke. The SCL was written in April 1968 and was made vague on purpose. The Lands Unit is responsible for the prevention of any contamination. Explanation of Amendments to law by Heather Jacobs-Whyte
 Also noted was that more media coverage to be done in TED and K103 because the community has to be well informed. Make an inquiry to Kahnawà:ke media sources for more coverage on the SCL to better inform the public and avoid any misinterpretation of the SCL
