| <p><b>2. <u>File Updates</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Repeal Process – All</b><br/>After some discussion about repealing Type I laws, it was noted that Type I laws for repeal would go through the CDMP and not be repealed.<br/><i>ACTION: KLCC then agreed to approve the Repeal Process. Leslie will schedule Council Discussions and bring it to Council for approval through a MCED.</i></li> <li>• <b>Evaluation of CDMP – All</b><br/>KLCC questioned what needs to be evaluated and what was the aim?<br/><i>ACTION: Discuss at next upcoming KLCC meeting.</i></li> <li>• <b>Approval CDMP Procedural Manual – Section 8.2 Procedure for Multiple Requests for Legislation or Amendments to Existing Legislation – All</b><br/>See attached 8.0 - Preparation Type I &amp; II Legislation that was revised by KLCC.<br/><i>ACTION: Recommendations:</i> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Draft laws should not be submitted or accepted;</li> <li>2) Only requests for laws should be submitted;</li> <li>3) The TDC develops the draft law; and</li> <li>4) Review above Draft Process at next KLCC monthly meeting.</li> </ol> </li> </ul> |  |
| <p><b>3. <u>Laws Update – Review/Decision</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Proposed Draft Kahnawà:ke Residency Law – Leslie Skye</b><br/>The First Hearing will likely occur in October after the Cannabis Law has been completed.</li> <li>• <b>Proposed Draft Kahnawà:ke Cannabis Control Law – Leslie Skye</b><br/>Two Information Sessions were held. The TDC is preparing to go to the First Hearing before the end of September.</li> </ul>   |  |
| <p><b>4. <u>Other</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>KLCC Legislative Calendar – All</b><br/>KLCC approved the draft agenda package for the 2018 – 2021 Legislative Calendar with minor grammatical changes.<br/><i>ACTION: Leslie to schedule Council Discussions &amp; Council Meeting for Council to approve 2018 – 2021 Legislative Calendar through a MCED.</i></li> <li>• <b>Regulations Process – Jean</b><br/>It was noted that the Kahnawà:ke Gaming Commission have concerns with the current Regulations Process that was passed by Council in June 2018.<br/><i>ACTION: Leslie to invite members of the KGC to attend the next KLCC meeting in November to discuss their concerns.</i></li> </ul>   |  |
