File Updates</b>	<p><b>Tobacco - February 10, 2015 Community Consultation:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-The Tobacco Community Consultation Agenda was reviewed and approved by Peggy &amp; KLCC.</li> <li>-Peggy advised that the following KTA representatives on the panel would be Devery Bauersfeld, Chucky McComber, Brian Delormier, Evan Standup, Kaienta'a Cross &amp; Randy Cross. Gina Deer and Bobby Patton will represent the MCK.</li> <li>-It was agreed that the KTA would give a historical background of the law explaining why it was created.</li> <li>-Gina as the MCK representative would explain the importance of the law and explain the details of the MOU between the KTA and the MCK.</li> </ul> <p><b>Two questions to be asked at the Consultation are:</b></p> <p><b>1) Does the community give the mandate to move the law through the CDMP?</b></p> <p><b>2) Does the community acknowledge that the Kahnawà:ke Tobacco Law is an urgent matter and needs to be expedited?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-The Purpose, Scope &amp; Intent and the feedback will be discussed at the First Hearing.</li> <li>-The selection of three community representatives will also be made at the First Hearing.</li> <li>-KLCC needs to direct people not on the KKR to the Observer's Table.
