Amendment Kahnawà:ke Animal Control Law - Leslie Skye

Public Safety should be ready to bring this law through the CDMP soon. Their front-end work has been completed.

ACTION: Leslie to follow-up with the Technical Drafting Committee to confirm when they'll be ready to bring the draft law through the Hearing Phase (Phase II).
