There are only 4 more sections to go through. The drafting team meets every Tuesday and Thursday to complete this task. ○ In the interest of efficiency, the Law is being updated by the drafting team as the hearing progresses and the community makes decisions on changes to the Law. ○ Need to replace Arlene Jacobs as a community representative over the summer. ○ Two upcoming meetings: June 7th and 14th.

Amendment Process DECISION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop Processes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Amendment process: borne due to the membership law being problematic because the community gives the scope, leading to the entire law being reviewed as opposed to only the specific sections being revised. The KML revision process cannot be changed mid-stream at this point. There should be an assessment to determine other laws & regulations that may be impacted to ensure consistency. SOD may be looking into this interconnectedness now. Suggestion to have proponent give the scope of the amendment, and use a 30 day review process to give the community input on the scope. Suggestion to have criteria for community member to be able to request change to scope; perhaps 150 signatures to change sections x, y, z. If an individual submits a request to amend a law, there has to be an assessment to determine if it is an important amendment. There should be sound reasoning and documentation to support the request. Portfolio Chiefs are responsible to make a review of the laws that are up for the mandatory 5 year review as well as requests for amendments. KLCC should remind C&C at the next monthly/quarterly update about Portfolio Chiefs being responsible. It is critical to have a review
