## Changes to the 2024-2027 Kahnawà:ke Legislative Agenda

For immediate release

**(Kahnawake – 13 Onerahtókha/April 2026)** The Kahnawà:ke Legislative Commission (KLC) wishes to announce changes to the 2024-2027 Legislative Agenda.

The original 2024-2027 Legislative Agenda included the *Kahnawà:ke Residency Law*, draft Kahnawà:ke Occupational Safety and Health Law (now referred to as the Kahnawà:ke Employment Code), and the draft Kahnawà:ke Tobacco Law, with two remaining spots to be filled from the Waiting List.

The two laws moving to the Legislative Agenda are the proposed Kahnawà:ke Environmental Law(s), and the *Kahnawà:ke Gaming Law*.

Exceptionally, there will be two more laws added as these laws require important timely amendments. The laws are, the *Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke Election Law* and *Kahnawà:ke Peacekeepers Law*, for a total of seven laws on the Legislative Agenda.

Further information regarding community meetings and engagement will be shared as they are scheduled.
