Two Regulations under the *Kahnawà:ke Justice Act* Repealed and Replaced

For immediate release

(Kahnawake – 1 Onerahtohkó:wa/May 2025) The Kahnawà:ke Legislative Commission (KLC) wishes to advise the community that *Regulation 1: Eligibility Criteria for Judges* and *Regulation 2: Selection Process for Judges* under the *Kahnawà:ke Justice Act* were repealed via Mohawk Council Resolution (MCR # 1/2025-2026). The numerous revisions required to render these regulations operational warranted that they be repealed and replaced.

They were respectively replaced with the [*Regulation Respecting Eligibility Criteria for Appointment of Judges of the Court of Kahnawà:ke*](#) and the [*Regulation Respecting the Selection and Appointment of Judges of the Court of Kahnawà:ke*](#).

The replacement regulations were enacted via individual Mohawk Council Executive Directives (MCED #10/2025-2026 and MCED #11/2025-2026) at a duly convened Council meeting held on 28 Onerahtókha/April 2025.

The official version of the two (2) regulations have been published on the Kahnawà:ke Community Decision Making and Review Process website, www.kahnawakemakingdecisions.com and are now in-force.
