(Kahnawake – 11 Onerahtohkó:wa/May 2026) The Kahnawà:ke Legislative Commission (KLC) wishes to advise the community that the 30-Day Feedback Period for the *Kahnawake Kahnawà:ke Residency Law* concluded on May 10, 2026. No feedback was received.

The first hearing for the *Kahnawà:ke Residency Law* is scheduled for **Wednesday, May 13, 2026**, at the **Legion Hall Upstairs** from **5pm to 8pm**. If the review of the proposed amendments is not completed, a future meeting date will be scheduled during the meeting.
