(Kahnawake – 21, Kenténha/October 2015) The Kahnawà:ke Legislative Coordinating Commission wishes to inform the community that the agenda has been set for the First Hearing for the proposed *Kahnawà:ke Tobacco Law*.

The intent is to create a law that will regulate the tobacco industry and is a joint effort between the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke and the Kahnawake Tobacco Association.

The agenda will be as follows: **a)** Selection of Community Reps; **b)** Section #1: *Jurisdiction*; **c)** Section #2: *Paramourty*; and **d)** Section #3: *Intent and Purpose*

As is standard procedure for creating or amending legislation, the meeting will utilize the Community Decision Making Process.
