

## Regulation Respecting Language and Culture Testing K.R.L c. R-3, r-7

This Regulation was enacted pursuant to section 21.1b of the *Kahnawà:ke Residency Law* (the “Law”) and approved by the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke on XXXX XX, 2019.

1. The purpose of this Regulation is to establish the setting of the level of language proficiency and cultural knowledge to be attained by the applicant through a standardized American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages assessment method and cultural knowledge test as required in section 10.3b of the Law.
2. The level of Kanien’kéha language acquisition will be set by a working group established for this purpose.
3. The culture test will be composed of a random assortment of questions developed by the working group established for this purpose. The group will set the passing grade requirement for the test and establish the process for its’ administration and grading.
4. This Regulation comes into force on the date fixed by Mohawk Council Executive Directive.
